

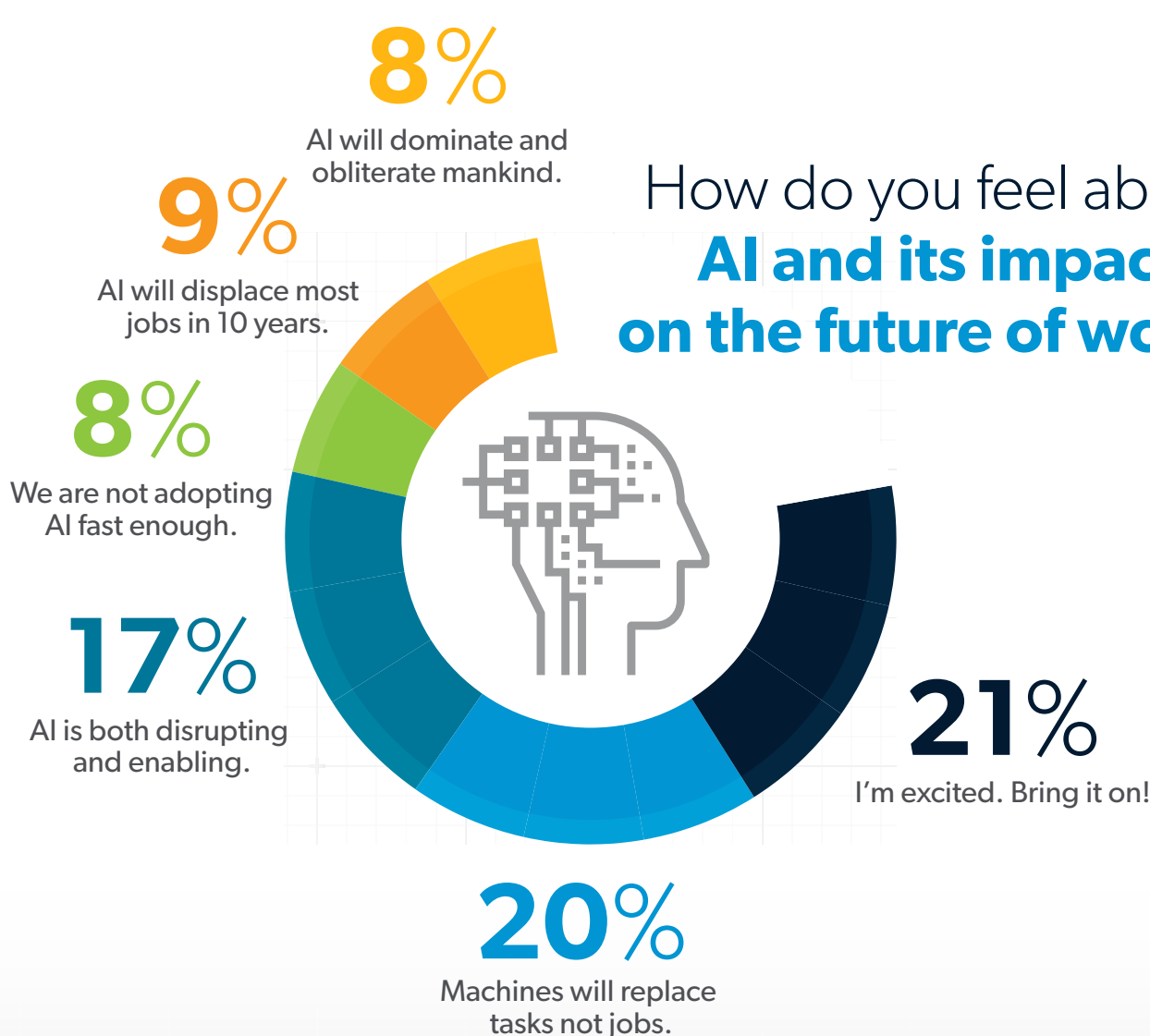
HR Professionals Take StOck of AI
